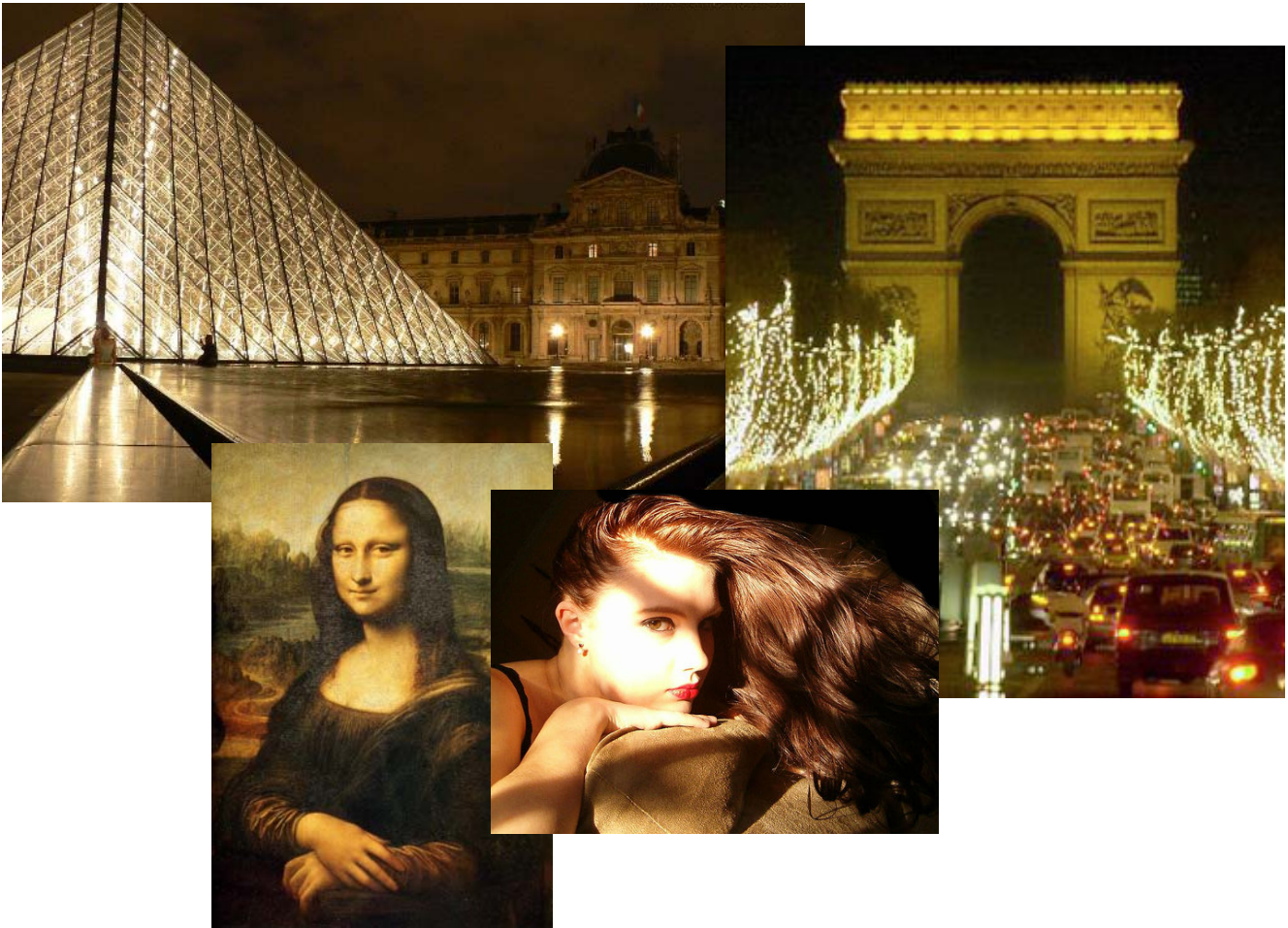

Day 5 / Paris (B, L)

Morning tour of the largest flea market in the world

Be a real Parisian today as we travel to the "*Le marche aux puces de Saint-Ouen*".

Our guides will escort you through this maze of shops and stalls and assist you if you wish to purchase anything.

The choice is large and the prices are moderate to high.

The flea market is very Parisian and very French. It will be a true shopping experience.



After our outing we venture to Montmartre and ride Le Petit Train de Montmartre to the top of Paris. View the skyline of Paris as you ride to the top of the mont in your private trolley, reserved exclusively for your group.



Montmartre, the Mount of Martyrs, is the home of the beautiful Basilica Sacre Coeur and the Church of St. Pierre, which has a claim to being the oldest church in Paris.



Our walking tour takes you to the old residences, studios and cafés of such artists as Pablo Picasso, Vincent Van Gogh, Claude Monet and Auguste Renoir, as well as the Moulin de la Galette, one of the two remaining windmills on. We will see the last of the vineyards that once covered the hill one of few remaining vineyards in Paris.

England's Sir Terence Conran has conquered Paris with Alcazar the bright, buzzing, and wonderfully stylish eatery on the left bank.

Located right off the St. Germain-Des-Près, Alcazar was also once home to a notorious transvestite bar and nightclub. The former club next door was the infamous "Rock 'N Roll Circus" nightclub which is known as the last place Jim Morrison was seen partying before he passed away on the same evening. Recently the place has been transformed with a 40 foot high glass roof, trendy decor and a changing series of photographic exhibits. The Mezzanine Bar above the restaurant is adored in Paris, not only for its drinks but also for the sounds its DJs mix. Food is French contemporary that includes a nod to the British owners with the "French Style" Fish & Chips.

And, if you want to party harder, they have a full scale club next door, the Wagg, which is just as cool.
